Since 2000, he has been a permanent staff member at Pediatric Oncology Unit of the Fondazione IRCCS Istituto Nazionale dei Tumori in Milan, where he holds the High-Specialization Position in Brain Tumors and leads the In-Hospital Exercise Program.

Personal statement

Filippo Spreafico is a pediatric oncologist at the Pediatric Unit of Fondazione IRCCS Istituto Nazionale Tumori in Milan. His international reputation is underscored by his leadership roles in the SIOP Renal Tumor

Study Group. As current vice-Chair, he fosters international networking on pediatric kidney tumors, and global outreach to improve cancer care in resource-limited countries.

For over 15 years, FS has chaired the Renal Tumors Working Group of the Associazione Italiana Ematologia Oncologia Pediatrica, leading national research efforts on pediatric kidney tumors and fostering collaborations both within Italy and internationally. He has been instrumental in integrating the national group into the broader SIOP international network.

FS has authored over 230 publications in high-impact journals such as *Lancet Oncology*, *Nature Reviews Disease Primers*, *Journal of Clinical Oncology*, and *European Journal of Cancer*, among others.

FS has initiated an in-hospital exercise program to promote supervised physical precision training as part of comprehensive cancer care in children and adolescents with cancer.

FS has successfully led major research projects funded by the Associazione Italiana Ricerca Cancro, the European Union, and the Italian Minister of Health, securing over €2 million in research funding as Principal Investigator.
